CHILDREN

NURSERY:

- ◆ During the **9:00 and 10:45 AM services**, infants and toddlers (2 years and under) are cared for in Room 127. A mother’s nursing area is located in the infant nursery.
- ◆ The back three rows on the west side of the sanctuary are reserved for parents to care for their children while attending church.

CHILDREN’S MINISTRY:

- ◆ 9:00 AM Service: the 2 yr olds - 5th grade attend Sunday School.
- ◆ 10:45 AM Service: the preschoolers meet in their own rooms, while K – 2nd grade have Children’s Church in Room 111. 3rd through 5th graders worship with their families.
- ◆ Sunday evening childcare is provided for Nursery through 5th grade during Adult Community Groups.
- ◆ AWANA is the Wednesday evening children’s program. Four year olds – 5th grade (6th grade optional) participate in Council Time (Singing and Lesson), Book Time (Memory Verses), and Game Time.

- I. The most effective witness for Jesus comes from friend to friend, relative to relative (John 1:35-42).
